

GATHER

1. Scissors
2. Gluestick or bottle of glue
3. Single holepuncher (or pencil)
4. Tape
5. Stiff thin material like a cereal box or thin box from amazon delivery or mail at least the size of a regular sheet of paper
6. A few different colored pieces of construction paper or other options
 - a. Gift tissue paper
 - b. Streamers
 - c. Color some small strips of white paper with the crayons or markers
7. 2 sheets of notebook paper
8. Yarn or other options
 - a. String
 - b. Ribbon
9. Crayons and markers

INSTRUCTIONS

Print

1. 2 copies of the anchor on regular paper
2. 1 copy of the word HOPE

Get the anchor ready

1. Use scissors to cut out both anchors and the front of the cereal box
2. Glue one anchor to the plain side of the cereal box or whatever you are using
3. Glue one piece of notebook paper on the printed side of the cereal box
4. Cut the anchor out that has been glued to the cereal box
5. Glue the second anchor over top of the notebook paper

Get the mosaic pieces ready

1. If you don't have construction paper, gift tissue, or streamers, use crayons or markers to color paper a few different colors. You don't need much!
2. Use scissors to cut out small sizes of colored paper to paste to the anchor about a 1/4" x 1/2" or less – cut different sizes to give that mosaic look


Get HOPE letters ready

1. Color and cut out the HOPE letters that was printed
2. Take the other piece of notebook paper and fold in half 3 times
3. Glue the letters to the top of the folded edge of the paper
4. Cut out the letters to make 3-D letters to paste to the anchor
 - a. Use the holepunch to make the hole in the center of the O and P, it's a lot easier than using the scissors
5. Tape the open ends of the letters
6. Press the top and the bottom of the letters to puff them out

Decorate the anchor

1. Choose one of the following scripture verses and write it on the side of the anchor with the two layers with a marker or pen:
 - a. We put our hope in the LORD
He is our help and our shield
– Psalm 22: 20
 - b. So be strong and courageous,
all you who put hope in the Lord
– Psalm 31:24
2. Flip to the other side and glue the word HOPE down the center bar of the anchor starting just below the big circle
3. Write IN GOD on the bottom of the anchor under the letter E
4. Take the pieces of colored paper and glue to the pointy tips and circles of the anchor
5. Tie the yarn to the top of the anchor

YOU'RE DONE! Hang it somewhere to remind yourself that you can always hope in Jesus!
